

Instructions for Producing Laminated Strips (Quick Alternative Method)

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PRODUCING ALTERNATIVE LAMINATED STRIP

1. For two laminated strips, make two photocopies of template 10.2–5. This template is found in a separate document found in the “templates folder of the 10.2 downloads with the filename “sla10-2_5_lamstrips_altmeth.pdf”. When printing this template, be sure to go into your “Page Set Up” and select “legal size” paper, or 8.5”x14”.
2. Using a paper cutter, cut out the top strip (for the front of the laminated strip) and the bottom strip (for the back of the laminated strip) Each cut out strip should measure 3” x 13 ½”.
3. Glue the two strips together back to back.
4. Laminate two strips at once using a laminator and an 8 ½” x 14” laminating sheet, making sure that there is a ¼” margin around each strip to secure the lamination.
5. Trim, leaving a ¼” margin.
